AMENDMENT OF THE CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 157 of the Conciliation and Arbitration Regulations is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation Judges and (2.) the words "Two pounds ten shillings" and inserting in their Conciliation stead the words "Three pounds three shillings".

2. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation Commencement on the first day of July, 1952.
