REGULATIONS UNDER THE COMMONWEALTH EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION ACT 1930-1951.*

AMENDMENTS OF THE EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 15 of the Employees' Compensation Regulations is amended by inserting after the words—

“The Council of the Canberra University College;”
the words—

“The Trustees of the Canberra Public Cemetery;”.

2. Regulation 18 of the Employees' Compensation Regulations is amended by inserting, after paragraph (a), the following paragraph:—

“(aa) a commissioned officer of the Defence Force who has attained the age of twenty-one years;”.
