- 4:—(1.) In addition to the sum referred to in the last preceding Further Issue, application and section, the Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund appropriation and appropriation and appropriation appropriation. and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to Her Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-five, such sums as the Treasurer from time to time determines.
- (2.) The sums granted by the last preceding sub-section are appropriated for the purposes of the Trust Account established under section sixty-two A of the Audit Act 1901-1954 and known as the Debt Redemption Reserve Trust Account.
