AMENDMENT OF THE EXPORTS (GENERAL) REGULATIONS.†

The Second Schedule to the Exports (General) Regulations is
amended by omitting paragraph 2 of the Third Column of Item 1A and
inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

Second
Schedule.

"2. For the purposes of the statement referred to in the last
preceding paragraph the year in which peas were harvested shall be
the period of 12 months ending on the 30th day of June next
succeeding the date of harvesting".
