REGULATION UNDER THE POST AND TELEGRAPH
ACT 1901-1950.*

AMENDMENT OF THE PICTUREGRAM REGULATIONS.†

Regulation 15 of the Picturegram Regulations is repealed and the
following regulation inserted in its stead:—

“15.—(1.) The rates for the transmission of picturegrams shall be in accordance with the following table:—”
Schedule of Rates.

Size of picture to be transmitted.	Rate per picture.
Within the limits of 7 inches by 5 inches	Three pounds seventeen shillings and sixpence
Exceeding the limits of 7 inches by 5 inches but not exceeding the limits of 9 inches by 7 inches	Four pounds seventeen shillings and sixpence
Exceeding the limits of 9 inches by 7 inches but not exceeding the limits of 10 inches by 8 inches	Five pounds twelve shillings and sixpence

“ (2.) For the purposes of sub-regulation (4.) of regulation 18 of these Regulations, the prescribed additional charge for each copy of a multiple picturegram after the first copy is an amount of Ten shillings.”.
