An Act to amend the Life Insurance Act 1945-1958.

 $B^E$  it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

Short title and citation, 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Life Insurance Act 1959.

(2.) The Life Insurance Act 1945-1958\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Life Insurance Act 1945-1959.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which commenceit receives the Royal Assent.
