REGULATIONS UNDER THE SEAMEN'S WAR PENSIONS AND ALLOWANCES ACT 1940-1961.*

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Seamen's War Pensions and Allowances Act* 1940-1961.

AMENDMENTS OF THE SEAMEN'S WAR PENSIONS AND ALLOWANCES REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 37 of the Seamen's War Pensions and Allowances Regulations is amended by omitting the words "Six pounds five shillings" and inserting in their stead the words "Seven pounds". Allowance to certain widows.

2. After regulation 42 of the Seamen's War Pensions and Allowances Regulations the following regulation is inserted:—

"42A.—(1.) The Commission may, either generally or otherwise as provided in the instrument of delegation, by writing under its seal, delegate to a person all or any of its powers and functions under these Regulations (except this power of delegation). Delegation of powers by Commission.

"(2.) A power or function so delegated may be exercised or performed by the delegate in accordance with the instrument of delegation.

"(3.) A delegation under this regulation is revocable at will and does not prevent the exercise of a power or the performance of a function by the Commission."

3. The amendment made by regulation 1 of these Regulations applies in relation to an instalment of an allowance that fell due on the twenty-sixth day of September, 1963, and to all subsequent instalments. Application.
