## REGULATIONS UNDER THE SEAMEN'S WAR PENSIONS AND ALLOWANCES ACT 1940-1961.\*

## AMENDMENTS OF THE SEAMEN'S WAR PENSIONS AND ALLOWANCES REGULATIONS.†

- 1. Regulation 37 of the Seamen's War Pensions and Allowances Regula- Allowance tions is amended by omitting the words "Six pounds five shillings" and to certain widows. inserting in their stead the words "Seven pounds".
- 2. After regulation 42 of the Seamen's War Pensions and Allowances Regulations the following regulation is inserted:—
- "42A.—(1.) The Commission may, either generally or otherwise as Delegation of provided in the instrument of delegation, by writing under its seal, delegate powers by Commission. to a person all or any of its powers and functions under these Regulations (except this power of delegation).
- "(2.) A power or function so delegated may be exercised or performed by the delegate in accordance with the instrument of delegation.
- "(3.) A delegation under this regulation is revocable at will and does not prevent the exercise of a power or the performance of a function by the Commission.".
- 3. The amendment made by regulation 1 of these Regulations applies Application. in relation to an instalment of an allowance that fell due on the twentysixth day of September, 1963, and to all subsequent instalments.
