MINISTERS OF STATE.

No. 1 of 1964.

An Act to amend the Ministers of State Act 1952–1959.

[Assented to 4th March, 1964.]

B^E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Ministers of State Act Short title and citation, 1964.

- (2.) The Ministers of State Act 1952-1959* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Ministers of State Act 1952-1964.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it Commencereceives the Royal Assent.

3. Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Number of the word "twenty-two" and inserting in its stead the word Ministers. " twenty-five ".

Salaries of Ministers. 4. Section five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "Sixty-six thousand six hundred" and inserting in their stead the words "Seventy-three thousand three hundred and fifty".
