REGULATIONS UNDER THE CUSTOMS ACT 1901-1963 AND THE
COMMERCE (TRADE DESCRIPTIONS) ACT 1905-1950*.

AMENDMENTS OF THE EXPORTS (GENERAL) REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 17 of the Exports (General) Regulations is amended by
omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (2.) the word "honey,".

2. Regulation 28 of the Exports (General) Regulations is amended by
omitting sub-regulation (3.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-
regulation:—

"(3.) The following offices are prescribed offices for the purpose of the
last preceding sub-regulation:—

- (a) Assistant Comptroller-General (being the office of that designa-
tion in the Laboratory Branch);
- (b) Chief Chemist;
- (c) Chemist Class III.;
- (d) Chemist Class II.; and
- (e) Chemist Class I."

3. The Second Schedule to the Exports (General) Regulations is amended
by omitting item 4.
