## National Health (No. 2)

## No. 146 of 1965

An Act to amend the *National Health Act* 1953–1964, as amended by the *National Health Act* 1965, in relation to Decimal Currency.

[Assented to 18 December, 1965]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the National Health Act (No. 2) 1965.
- (2.) The National Health Act 1953-1964,\* as amended by the National Health Act 1965,† is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

- (3.) Section 1 of the National Health Act 1965 is amended by omitting sub-section (2.).
- (4.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the National Health Act 1953-1965.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the fourteenth day commenceof February, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six.

- 3. Section 22 of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section inserted in its stead:
- "22. Where an amount ascertained in accordance with this Payment to Part, as affected by the Currency Act 1965, is not a multiple of next multiple of five cents, the amount of cents shall be increased to the nearest of five cents. higher amount that is a multiple of Five cents.".
