AMENDMENTS OF THE HIGH COMMISSIONER (STAFF) REGULATIONS[†]

1. Regulation 4 of the High Commissioner (Staff) Regulations is amended by Interpretation. omitting sub-regulation (2.) and inserting in its stead the following subregulation:-

"(2.) A reference in a regulation, other than regulation 4A, of these Regulations, or in a Schedule to these Regulations, to an amount of money shall be read as a reference to that amount of money in sterling.".

2.-(1.) Regulation 4A of the High Commissioner (Staff) Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (5.) the words "Eleven thousand seven hundred and twenty-eight dollars " and inserting in their stead the words " Thirteen thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight dollars ".

(2.) The rate of salary specified in sub-regulation (5.) of regulation 4A of the High Commissioner (Staff) Regulations as amended by the last preceding subregulation applies in relation to service by a Deputy High Commissioner, other than a Deputy High Commissioner to whom sub-regulation (4.) of that regulation applies, on or after the twenty-fifth day of September, 1969.

3. The Fourth Schedule to the High Commissioner (Staff) Regulations is Fourth Schedule. repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these Regulations is inserted in its stead.

4. Where, during any period that commenced on or after the first day of July, 1969, and ended before the commencement of these Regulations, an officer or employee occupied or performed the duties of an office set out in column 1 of the Fourth Schedule to the High Commissioner (Staff) Regulations, as in force 1969, and at the commencement of these Regulations, the officer or employee shall, by force of this regulation, be paid an allowance of such an amount as would result in of these Regulations.

- (b) that rate or that scale of rates had been specified in column 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the High Commissioner (Staff) Regulations opposite to that office in column 1.
