AMENDMENTS OF THE JURY EXEMPTION REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 3 of the Jury Exemption Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (f) of sub-regulation (2.) the word "and"; and
- (b) by adding at the end of sub-regulation (2.) the following paragraphs:—
 - "(r) the Commissioner for Employees' Compensation; and
 - (s) a person constituting a Commonwealth Employees' Compensation Tribunal."

Exemption of members of specified statutory bodies.

2.—(1.) The First Schedule to the Jury Exemption Regulations is amended by omitting Part XVI, and inserting in its stead the following Part:—
