AMENDMENT OF THE PARLIAMENTARY COUNSEL REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 4 of the Parliamentary Counsel Regulations is amended by Travelling omitting from sub-regulation (2.) the words "Twenty-eight dollars" and allowance. "Twenty-one dollars" and inserting in their stead the words "Thirty-four dollars" and " Twenty-five dollars ", respectively.

2. The rates specified in sub-regulation (2.) of regulation 4 of the Parlia-Application. mentary Counsel Regulations as amended by these Regulations apply-

- (a) in relation to travelling allowance paid or payable to the First Parliamentary Counsel-in respect of travel on the seventeenth day of May, 1972, or any subsequent day; and
- (b) in relation to travelling allowance paid or payable to a Second Parliamentary Counsel-in respect of travel on the twenty-fourth day of January, 1972, or any subsequent day.
