REGULATIONS UNDER THE PARLIAMENTARY COUNSEL ACT 1970-1971.*

AMENDMENT OF THE PARLIAMENTARY COUNSEL REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 4 of the Parliamentary Counsel Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (2.) the words "Twenty-eight dollars" and "Twenty-one dollars" and inserting in their stead the words "Thirty-four dollars" and "Twenty-five dollars", respectively. Travelling allowance.

2. The rates specified in sub-regulation (2.) of regulation 4 of the Parliamentary Counsel Regulations as amended by these Regulations apply— Application.

- (a) in relation to travelling allowance paid or payable to the First Parliamentary Counsel—in respect of travel on the seventeenth day of May, 1972, or any subsequent day; and
- (b) in relation to travelling allowance paid or payable to a Second Parliamentary Counsel—in respect of travel on the twenty-fourth day of January, 1972, or any subsequent day.
