Interim Forces Benefits Act 1973

AN ACT

To amend the Interim Forces Benefits Act 1947-1966.

[Assented to 16 March 1973]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, the Senate and the House of Representatives of Australia, as follows:—

- Short title and citation.
- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Interim Forces Benefits Act 1973.
- (2) The Interim Forces Benefits Act 1947 1966,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Interim Forces Benefits Act 1947-1973.
- Commencement.
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. After section 7 of the *Interim Forces Benefits Act* 1947–1966 the following section is inserted:
- Application of section 120c of Repatriation Act.
- "7A. Section 120c of the Repatriation Act 1920-1973 applies in relation to a pension, allowance or other benefit under this Act or the regulations as if it were a pension, allowance or other benefit under that Act.".
