Section 1

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *National Residue Survey Levies Regulations (Validation and Commencement of Amendments) Act 1999*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3 Validation and commencement of regulations

- (1) The Primary Industries Levies and Charges (National Residue Survey Levies) Regulations 1998 (Amendment) (Statutory Rules No. 182 of 1998) are taken to be valid and, despite regulation 1 of those regulations, are taken to have commenced on 1 August 1998.

Note: Subsection 48(2) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* (which limits the circumstances in which regulations may take effect retrospectively) does not affect the operation of this section.

- (2) Other regulations made before or after the commencement of this Act that amend the *Primary Industries Levies and Charges (National Residue Survey Levies) Regulations 1998* have the same effect as they would have had if the regulations to which subsection (1) applies had actually commenced on 1 August 1998.
