# **STATES GRANTS (ADVANCED EDUCATION)** AMENDMENT ACT (No. 2) 1976

# No. 120 of 1976

An Act to amend the States Grants (Advanced Education) Act 1972 and the States Grants (Advanced Education) Act 1976.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

# PART I-PRELIMINARY

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the States Grants (Advanced Edu- Short title. &c. cation) Amendment Act (No. 2) 1976.1

(2) Section 1 of the States Grants (Advanced Education) Act 1972 (being Act No. 58, 1972) is amended by omitting sub-section (1) and substituting the following sub-section:-

"(1) This Act may be cited as the States Grants (Advanced Education) Amendment Act 1972.".

(3) The amendment made by sub-section (2) does not affect any amendment made by the States Grants (Advanced Education) Act (No. 2) 1972.<sup>2</sup>

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives Commencement. the Royal Assent.<sup>1</sup>
