## STATES GRANTS (COAL MINING INDUSTRY LONG SERVICE LEAVE) AMENDMENT ACT 1977

## No. 137 of 1977

An Act to amend the States Grants (Coal Mining Industry Long Service Leave) Act 1949.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the States Grants (Coal Mining Industry Short title Long Service Leave) Amendment Act 1977.1
- 2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 17 Commencement August 1977.
- 3. Section 3 of the States Grants (Coal Mining Industry Long Service Coal Mining) Leave) Act 1949<sup>2</sup> is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of sub-section Industry Long Service (3) and substituting the following paragraphs:

Leave Fund

- "(a) amounts equal to amounts raised as duties of Excise on—
  - (i) coal in respect of which an entry authorizing the removal of the coal from a coal mine was made before the hour of 2 o'clock in the morning by standard time in the Australian Capital Territory on 17 August 1977; or
  - (ii) coal removed before that hour, without entry, in pursuance of sub-section 24 (2) of the *Coal Excise Act* 1949;
- "(aa) amounts equal to two-thirds of the amounts from time to time raised as duties of Excise on coal, other than coal to which paragraph (a) applies; and ".
