

Health Insurance Amendment Act (No. 2) 1979

No. 123 of 1979

An Act to amend section 3 of the *Health Insurance Act* 1973.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen, and the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:

Short title,
&c.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Health Insurance Amendment Act* (No. 2) 1979.¹

(2) The *Health Insurance Act* 1973² is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Commence-
ment

2. This Act shall come into operation on 1 November 1979.

Interpret-
ation

3. Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting in sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (a) of the definition of “eligible pensioner” in sub-section (1) “, a supporting parent’s benefit” after “widow’s pension”; and
- (b) by inserting in sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of that definition “, benefit” after “pension”.
