## REGULATIONS UNDER THE NAVIGATION ACT 1912.\*

## AMENDMENTS OF THE NAVIGATION (DECK CARGO AND LIVE STOCK) REGULATIONS†

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 January 1977.

Commencement.

2. Regulation 6 of the Navigation (Deck Cargo and Live Stock) Regulations is amended—

Notice of intention to load live stock or deck cargo.

- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (5) the words "Two pounds" and substituting the figure "\$6";
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (6) the words "Five pounds five shillings" and substituting the figures "\$16";
- (c) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (6) the words "Two pounds two shillings" and substituting the figure "\$7";
- (d) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (6) the words "Four pounds four shillings" and substituting the figures "\$13"; and
- (e) by omitting from sub-regulation (8) the words "Two pounds" and substituting the figure "\$6".
