## Extradition (Republic of Italy) Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulation under the *Extradition (Foreign States) Act 1966*.

Regulations 2 and 3 of the Extradition (Republic of Italy) Regulations are repealed and the following regulations substituted:

### Interpretation

"2. In these Regulations, 'the Act' means the *Extradition (Foreign States) Act 1966*.

### Application of Act

"3. The Act applies in relation to the Republic of Italy subject to the following treaties:

- (a) the Treaty of Extradition between Australia and the Republic of Italy that came into force on 9 May 1976 (being the treaty a copy of the English text of which is set out in the Schedule);
- (b) the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Seizure of Aircraft (being the Convention referred to in the *Crimes (Hijacking of Aircraft) Act 1972*);

- (c) the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts against the Safety of Civil Aviation (being the Convention referred to in the *Crimes (Protection of Aircraft) Act 1973*);
  - (d) the Single Convention on Narcotic Drugs, 1961 as subsequently amended (being the Convention referred to in, and a copy of the English text of which is set out in the Schedule to, the Extradition (Narcotic Drugs) Regulations.”.
