Fisheries Levy (East Coast Tuna Purse Seine Fishery) Regulations

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries Levy (East Coast Tuna Purse Seine Fishery) Regulations.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears:

“**endorsement**” means an endorsement of a licence under subsection 9 (4) of the *Fisheries Act 1952*;

“**licence**” means a licence granted under subsection 9 (2) or (3) of the *Fisheries Act 1952*;

“**notice**” means Fisheries Notice No. TEC 2 published in the *Gazette* on 30 July 1990 and in force under section 8 of the *Fisheries Act 1952*;

“**the Act**” means the *Fisheries Levy Act 1984*.

Prescribed class of endorsement—paragraph 5 (b) of the Act

3. Each of the following classes of endorsements is prescribed for the purposes of paragraph 5 (b) of the Act:

- (a) an endorsement referred to in paragraph 5 (a) of the notice;
and
- (b) an endorsement referred to in paragraph 5 (b) of the notice.

Amount of levy—subsection 6 (1) of the Act

4. For the purposes of subsection 6 (1) of the Act, the following amounts are specified:

- (a) for endorsement of a licence included in the class of endorsements referred to in paragraph 5 (a) of the notice—\$2,000; and
- (b) for endorsement of a licence included in the class of endorsements referred to in paragraph 5 (b) of the notice—\$1,000.
