Regulation 56A of the Postal Services Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:

Prescribed amount for purposes of section 82 of the Act

“56A. The higher amount for the purposes of section 82 of the Act is:

- (a) in respect of a contract entered into for the purposes of section 75A or subsection 78 (2) of the Act—\$50,000,000; and
- (b) in any other case—\$6,000,000.”.
