## Wireless Telegraphy Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulation under the *Wireless Telegraphy Act 1905*.

After regulation 65 of the Wireless Telegraphy Regulations the following Part is inserted:

### "PART IVA—ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS RELATING TO CITIZEN BAND RADIO STATIONS

#### **Emergency channels**

"65A. The licensee of a citizen band radio station shall not, except in cases of emergency, operate that station on a carrier frequency of 27.065 or 476.525 megahertz.

#### **Call channels**

"65B. (1) Subject to sub-regulation (2) the licensee of a citizen band radio station shall not operate that station on a carrier frequency of 27.085, 27.155 or 476.675 megahertz except—

- (a) for the purpose of initiating contact with other citizen band radio stations; or
- (b) in cases of emergency, where both the carrier frequencies referred to in regulation 65A are not available.

“(2) The carrier frequencies referred to in sub-regulation (1) shall not be used, except—

- (a) in the case of a carrier frequency of 27.085 megahertz—for double sideband amplitude modulated transmissions;
  - (b) in the case of a carrier frequency of 27.155 megahertz—for single sideband amplitude modulated transmissions employing the lower sideband of that carrier frequency; and
  - (c) in the case of a carrier frequency of 476.675 megahertz—for angle modulated transmissions.”.
