### Spirits Regulations<sup>2</sup> (Amendment)

#### Section 12

Regulation 9B of the Spirits Regulations is amended by omitting —  
“ferro china”  
and substituting —  
“ferro china  
fruit brandies (other than brandy distilled from grapes)”.
