## New South Wales Class 1 Special Purpose Vehicles Notice Amendment Notice 2015 (No. 1)

#### 1 Purpose

(1) The purpose of this notice is to make minor amendments to the *Class 1 Special Purpose Vehicles Notice 2014* published in the New South Wales Government Gazette No 15 of 7 February 2014, at pages 387 to 425.

#### 2 Authorising Provision

This notice is made under Section 117, and Section 23 of Schedule 1, of the Heavy Vehicle National Law.

#### 3 Period of operation

- (1) Subject to Subsection (2), this notice commences on the date of its publication in the Commonwealth Gazette and is in force until 9 February 2019.
- (2) Paragraphs 4(1)(c),(d), (f) and (g) come into force 28 days after this notice is published in the Commonwealth Gazette.

#### 4 Amendment of 2014 Notice

- (1) The Class 1 Special Purpose Vehicles Notice 2014 is amended as follows—
  - (a) In Table 2 (Mass limits for axles and axle groups) of Part 4 of the Schedule, the seventh row ('with a load-sharing suspension system'), column 2, omit '14.0' and insert—
