Birds Protection Regulations 1988

Short title

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Birds Protection Regulations 1988*.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations, “Act” means the *Birds Protection Act 1913*.

Protected birds

3. For the purposes of the definition of “protected bird” in section 2 of the Act, each species and sub-species of bird is a prescribed species, other than —
 - (a) a species or sub-species specified in the Schedule;
 - (b) a species or sub-species of birds in danger of extinction specified in Schedule 2 to the *Migratory Birds Act 1980*; or
 - (c) a species or sub-species of migratory birds specified in Schedule 3 to the *Migratory Birds Act 1980*.
