### 1 Name

This is the *Radiocommunications (Fee Charging – Amateur Licences) Determination 2019*.

### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences at the start of the day after it is gazetted.

### 3 Determination

- (1) Under subsection 298A(1) of the Act, the ACMA determines that the University of Tasmania, being approved by the ACMA as mentioned in paragraph (b) of the definition of ***approved examination*** in subsection 122(2) of the Act, may charge fees for performing its functions under the Act.

- (2) In this section:

***ACMA*** means the Australian Communications and Media Authority.

***Act*** means the *Radiocommunications Act 1992*.

***University of Tasmania*** means the University of Tasmania, a body corporate continued in existence by section 4 of the *University of Tasmania Act 1992* (Tas).
