### KAKADU NATIONAL PARK

### PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF ROADS AND TRACKS WITHIN THE PARK

I, Jody Swirepik, Acting Director of National Parks, acting pursuant to the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Regulations* 2000 (**Regulations**):

1. REVOKE the prohibition instrument dated 16 April 2021 concerning the use of certain roads and tracks, and activities in Kakadu National Park (**Park**); and

having taken into account and being satisfied that prohibiting access to and activities in certain areas in the Kakadu National Park (**Park**) is necessary for Aboriginal cultural purposes:

- 2. PROHIBIT pursuant to subregulations 12.23A(3), 12.42(1) and 12.55(4) of the Regulations, all persons, at all times this prohibition is in effect:
  - a. engaging in any activities in the Merl Campground; and
  - b. using any of the following roads and tracks for all vehicles, walking and riding:
    - Ubirr Road, from the Oenpelli Road turn-off;
    - the Bardedjilidji walk;
    - the Badbong Wodjmeng sandstone river walk; and
    - the Manngarre rainforest walk.
