## **Aviation Transport Security Act 2004**

## NTC-27075 – DECLARATION OF SECURITY CONTROLLED AIRPORT AND ESTABLISHMENT OF AIRSIDE AREA – ALBURY AIRPORT

I am a Delegate of the Secretary of the Department of Home Affairs. Under subsection 28(2) of the *Aviation Transport Security Act 2004* (the Act), I:

**REVOKE** notice NTC-26713 which declared Albury Airport as a security controlled airport as published in the *Gazette (C2024G00425, 11 July 2024)*; and

**DECLARE** Albury Airport is a security controlled airport, the boundaries of Albury Airport are shown on the attached map which forms part of this notice; and

**ESTABLISH**, in accordance with section 29 of the Act, an airside area for Albury Airport being that area indicated as the airside area on the attached map which forms part of this notice.

This Notice commences upon publication in the Gazette.
