REGURATION UNDER THE WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT 1014-1016.

I THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth, of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulation under the War Precautions Act 1914-1916, to counce into operation forthwith.

WAR PRECAUTIONS (SUPPLEMENTARY) REQUIATIONS.

(Statutory Rules 1016, No. 97, as amended by Statutory Rules 1016, Nos. 112, 122, 128, 129, 167, 248, 219, 250, 252, 254, 255, 263, and 271.)

After Regulation 17 of the War Precautions (Supplementary) Regulations the following Regulation is inserted:--

"18. No person shall publish exhibit or announce, in any theatre ruble or place of public entertainment, any figures purporting to be saintained announcement results of the referendum held under the Military Service or recording Referendum Act 1916."
