## REGULATION UNDER THE ENTERTAINMENTS TAX ASSESSMENT ACT 1916.

## AMENDMENT OF THE ENTERTAINMENTS TAX REGULATIONS 1917.

(Statutory Rules 1917, No. 227.)

The Schedule to the Entertainments Tax Regulations is amended by omitting from Condition 1 of the General Conditions of Form A the words "such summary will be accepted" and inserting in their stead the words "such summary may, at the discretion of the Deputy Commissioner, be accepted." Amendment of Form A.
