## REGULATIONS UNDER THE MEAT EXPORT CONTROL ACT 1935.\*

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Meat Export Control Act 1935*.

### MEAT EXPORT CONTROL (EXPENSES) REGULATIONS.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Meat Export Control Citation, (Expenses) Regulations.

2.—(1.) Where any member attends a meeting of the Board or of the Committee, as the case may be, he shall be reimbursed the expenses incurred by him in connexion with his attendance at that meeting: Expenses of members.

(2.) In this regulation "member" means a member of the Board or of the Executive Committee of the Board or the Beef Committee of the Board, and includes the Chairman of the Board and any deputy of a member of the Board.
