REGULATIONS UNDER THE PUBLIC ACCOUNTS COMMITTEE ACT 1951.*

AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC ACCOUNTS COMMITTEE REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 2 of these Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of May, 1957. Commencement.

2. Regulation 5 of the Public Accounts Committee Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (c) of sub-regulation (1.) the words "Two pounds ten shillings" and inserting in their stead the words "Three pounds thirteen shillings and sixpence". Prescribed allowances.
