| Citation.   | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Meat Export Charge Regulations.  |
| Definition.   | 2. In these Regulations, "the Act" means the <i>Meat Export Charge Act 1973</i> .   |
| Meat exempt from charge under section 5 of the Act. | 3. Each of the following classes of meat is declared, for the purposes of paragraph 5(b) of the Act, to be a class of meat that is exempt from charge:—<br>(a) the class of meat referred to in paragraph 7 (b) of the Exports (Meat) Regulations;<br>(b) the class of meat referred to in regulation 9 of those regulations. |
