## REGULATIONS UNDER THE DAIRY PRODUCE ACT 1924.\*

I, THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Dairy Produce Act 1924*.

### DAIRY PRODUCE REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Regulations. Citation.
2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 July 1977. Commence-  
ment.
3. In these Regulations, "the Act" means the *Dairy Produce Act 1924*. Interpret-  
ation.
4. (1) For the purposes of the definition of "dairy produce" in section 3 of the Act, whole milk powder is prescribed. Prescribed  
product for  
purposes of  
definition of  
"dairy  
produce".  
(2) In sub-regulation (1), "whole milk powder" has the same meaning as in the *Dairy Industry Stabilization Levy Act 1977*.
5. Section 20AA of the Act does not apply in relation to dairy products of any of the following classes:— Section 20AA  
of the Act not  
to apply in  
relation to  
certain classes  
of dairy  
products.
  - (a) processed butteroil produced from butter that was produced before 1 July 1977;
  - (b) processed cheese produced from cheese that was produced before 1 July 1977;
  - (c) whole milk powder produced before 1 July 1978.
6. (1) For the purposes of sub-section 20AB (2) of the Act, a pool shall be set up in respect of dairy products of each of the kinds specified in the Schedule that are produced during a production period. Pools to be set  
up and  
maintained.  
(2) A pool shall be maintained in accordance with the accounting principles generally applied in commercial practice.
