## A BILL

FOR

## AN ACT

Relating to the Governor-General's  
Establishment.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

**5**     **1.** This may be cited as the *Governor-General's Establishment* Short title.  
*Act* 1902.

**10**     **2.** To assist in defraying the expenses of the Governor-General's establishment there shall be paid to him out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, from the first day of January One thousand nine hundred and one until the occupation of his residence at the seat of Government and for one year thereafter, an allowance of Eight thousand pounds a year, and the Consolidated Revenue Fund is hereby appropriated accordingly for that purpose. Allowance to Governor-General.



THIS Bill originated in the House of Representatives ; and having this day passed, is now ready for presentation to the Senate for its concurrence.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble  
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of  
Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in  
the House of Representatives, as follows:—

5     **1.** This Act may be cited as the *Governor-General's Establishment* Short title.  
*Act 1902.*

10     **2.** To assist in defraying the expenses of the Governor-  
General's establishment in connexion with the visit to Australia of  
Their Royal Highnesses the Duke and Duchess of Cornwall and York  
there shall be paid to him out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund  
an extraordinary allowance of Ten thousand pounds, and the Con-  
solidated Revenue Fund is hereby appropriated accordingly for that  
purpose. Allowance to  
Governor-General.
