A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

Relating to Military Canteens.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Canteen Act* 1905. Short title.
 - 5 2. The sale of or dealing in beer, wine, or any intoxicating liquors by any person in any military camp or canteen, or any army transport, or upon any premises used for military purposes by the Commonwealth is hereby prohibited. Prohibition of sale of intoxicants in military camps, &c.
- Penalty : Twenty-five pounds.
