THE PARLIAMENT OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Read 1^o 28 June, 1906.

(Brought in by the Minister for Home Affairs, the Honorable L. E. Groom.)

A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

Relating to the Residences of the Governor-General.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Governor-General's Residences Act* 1906. Short title.

2. The Governor-General may enter into an arrangement with the Governor of the State of Victoria for the use and occupation by the Commonwealth, for a period not exceeding five years, of Government House, Melbourne, as a residence for the Governor-General. Arrangement for use of Government House, Melbourne.

3. The Governor-General may enter into an arrangement with the Governor of the State of New South Wales for the use and occupation by the Commonwealth, for a period not exceeding five years, of Government House, Sydney, as a residence for the Governor-General. Arrangement for use of Government House, Sydney.

THIS Bill originated in the House of Representatives; and, having this day passed, is now ready for presentation to the Senate for its concurrence.

Relating to the Residences of the Governor-General.

FOR the purpose of providing Residences for the Governor-General, pending the establishment of the Federal Capital: Preamble.
Be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
5 Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Governor-General's Residences Act 1906.* Short title.

2. The Governor-General may enter into an arrangement with the Governor of the State of Victoria for the use and occupation by the
10 Commonwealth, for a period not exceeding five years, of Government House, Melbourne, as a residence for the Governor-General. Arrangement for use of Government House, Melbourne.

3. The Governor-General may enter into an arrangement with the Governor of the State of New South Wales for the use and occupation by the Commonwealth, for a period not exceeding five years, of
15 Government House, Sydney, as a residence for the Governor-General. Arrangement for use of Government House, Sydney.
