# AN ACT

Relating to the Residences of the Governor-General.

BE it enacted by the King's most reasonable and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate Australia, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Governor-General's Residences short title. 5 Act 1906.
  - 2. The Governor-General may enter into an arrangement with the Arrangement Governor of the State of Victoria for the use and occupation by the Government Commonwealth, for a period not exceeding five years, of Government House, Melbourne. House, Melbourne, as a residence for the Governor-General.

3. The Governor-General may enter into an arrangement with the Arrangement Governor of the State of New South Wales for the use and occupation for use o Government by the Commonwealth, for a period not exceeding five years, of House, Sydney. Government House, Sydney, as a residence for the Governor-General.

This Bill originated in the House of Representatives; and, having this day passed, is now ready for presentation to the Senate for its concurrence.

## AN ACT

Relating to the Residences of the Governor-General.

POR the purpose of providing Residences for the Governor-Preamble.

General, pending the establishment of the Governor-Preamble. General, pending the establishment of the Federal Capital: Be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of 5 Australia, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Governor-General's Residences Short title. Act 1906.
- 2. The Governor-General may enter into an arrangement with the Arrangement Governor of the State of Victoria for the use and occupation by the Government 10 Commonwealth, for a period not exceeding five years, of Government Melbourne. House, Melbourne, as a residence for the Governor-General.

3. The Governor-General may enter into an arrangement with the Governor of the State of New South Wales for the use and occupation for use of Government by the Commonwealth, for a period not exceeding five years, of House, Sydney. 15 Government House, Sydney, as a residence for the Governor-General.
