A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

To amend the *Post and Telegraph Rates Act 1902*.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

5 1. This Act may be cited as the *Tasmanian Cable Rates Act 1906* and shall commence on the first day of October One thousand nine hundred and six. Short title and commencement.

10 2. The Second Schedule to the *Post and Telegraph Rates Act 1902* is amended by omitting therefrom wherever they occur the words "on telegrams from and to Tasmania the charges to be those mentioned above with cable charges added." Omission of Tasmanian cable charges.



This Bill originated in the House of Representatives ; and, having this day passed, is now ready for presentation to the Senate for its concurrence.
