A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

To Authorize the Survey of Route for a Railway
to connect Kalgoorlie, in the State of Western
Australia, with Port Augusta, in the State of
South Australia.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in
the House of Representatives, as follows :—

- 5 1. This Act may be cited as the *Kalgoorlie to Port Augusta Railway Survey Act 1904.* Short title.
2. The Minister may cause a survey to be made of a route for a railway to connect Kalgoorlie, in the State of Western Australia, with Port Augusta, in the State of South Australia. Power to make survey of route.
- 10 3. The cost of the survey authorized by this Act shall not exceed Twenty thousand pounds, and shall be charged on and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly. Appropriation of money.
