A BILL

AN ACT

To amend Section Seven of the Post and Telegraph Act 1901-1913.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:-

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Post and Telegraph Act Short title and citation. 5 1916.
 - (2.) The Post and Telegraph Act 1901-1913, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Post and Telegraph Act 1901-1916.
- 2. Section seven of the Post and Telegraph Act 1901-1913 is Amendment the words "Provided of s. 7. amended by adding at the end thereof the words "Provided 10 that if the Governor-General notifies by proclamation that for the purposes of the administration of the Department any portion of a State or Territory is attached to any adjoining State, the Deputy Postmaster-General of that adjoining State shall be the principal officer of the Department in the portion so attached.'
