## A BILL

FOR

## AN ACT

To amend Section Seven of the *Post and Telegraph Act 1901-1913*.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Post and Telegraph Act* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Post and Telegraph Act 1901-1913*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Post and Telegraph Act 1901-1916*.

2. Section seven of the *Post and Telegraph Act 1901-1913* is Amendment of s. 7. amended by adding at the end thereof the words "Provided  
10 that if the Governor-General notifies by proclamation that for the purposes of the administration of the Department any portion of a State or Territory is attached to any adjoining State, the Deputy Postmaster-General of that adjoining State shall be the principal officer of the Department in the portion so attached."
