A BILL
FOR
AN ACT

To amend the *Post and Telegraph Act* 1901-1916.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Post and Telegraph Act* 1921. Short title and citation.

(2.) *The Post and Telegraph Act* 1901-1916 as amended by this Act may be cited as the *Post and Telegraph Act* 1901-1921.

2. Section eighteen of the *Post and Telegraph Act* 1901-1916 is amended— Compensation for carriage of mails on railways.

(a) by omitting therefrom the words “the receipt carriage and delivery of mails and for all facilities provided in connexion therewith” and inserting in their stead the words “rendering any service required in pursuance of the last preceding section”; and

(b) by inserting therein, after the word “arbitration” the words “on the basis of the actual expense estimated to have been incurred in rendering such service”.
