A BILL  
FOR  
AN ACT

To amend the *Parliamentary Allowances Act 1920.*

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Allowances Amendment Act 1920.* Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Parliamentary Allowances Act 1920* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2. This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by Proclamation after the King's approval thereto has been proclaimed in the Commonwealth. Commencement

3. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "One thousand", and inserting in their stead the words "Six hundred". Also by omitting the word "eight" in the last line but one, and inserting in its stead the word "four". Amendment of s. 3.

4. Section five of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "election" the words "to the date of the next following election". Amendment of s. 5.

5. Section seven of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word "two" in the third line, and inserting in its stead the word "one". Also by omitting the word "four" in the fifth line, and inserting in its stead the word "two". Amendment of s. 7.
