A BILL

FOR

AN ACT

To amend the *Spirits Act* 1906-1918.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Spirits Act* 1923.
- 5 (2.) The *Spirits Act* 1906-1918, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Spirits Act* 1906-1923.

Short title and citation.

2. Section four of the *Spirits Act* 1906-1918 is amended by inserting therein after the word "Parts" the number "XI".
