To amend section five of the *Land Tax Assessment
 Act 1910-1923.*

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate,
 and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of
 Australia, as follows:—

- 1.---(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Land Tax Assessment Act* Short title.

 as the *Land Tax Assessment Act 1910-1924.*
