**A BILL
FOR
AN ACT**

Relating to Main Roads Development.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

5 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Main Roads Development Act* Short title and citation. 1924.

(2.) The *Main Roads Development Act* 1923 is, in this Act, referred to as the Principal Act.

10 (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Main Roads Development Act* 1923-1924.

2. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting there- Appropriation. from the words "Five hundred thousand pounds" and inserting in their stead the words "One million pounds".

15 3. The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words and figures— Amendment of Schedule.
